### The Deacon's Corner

#### Our Lenten Journey

Our Lenten Journey began on Ash Wednesday when we were reminded that *from dust we came and to dust we will return and that we are to repent and believe in the Gospel of the Lord.*

From there our journey continued as we accompanied Christ out into the desert for 40 days and be tempted by the devil. During these 40 days we too experienced those temptations...those of worldly life. We came to realize that we are a fallen people and creatures of a fallen world and, hopefully, learned that Heaven is our true home.

As the journey comes close to its end we begin to see a glimmer of light in the darkness...and that light is Christ, Himself, coming to meet us and lead us by the hand.

But, when does he lead us? Christ leads us to Calvary, because that's the only path out of the desert and the only path that leads us home.
