## The Deacon's Corner

### The Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This past July I wrote about the 15 Promises of the Holy Rosary, which is one of the most important devotional prayers of the Church and a devotional we should consider praying daily.

Today I wish to get a bit into this lovely instrument of prayer in which we direct our minds and our hearts and our minds to God as we pray. The Holy Rosary was given to Saint Dominic, the first great apostle, by Our Blessed Lady in the year 1214 when he was 51 years old. The last great apostle of the Holy Rosary was Saint Louis Marie de Montfort, who died in 1717 at the age of 43. In the year 1571 Saint Pius V established October 7<sup>th</sup> as the feast of the Most Holy Rosary. Since that time many important events have occurred which have been attributed to the Rosary, beginning with the victory of the Catholic Church in the great naval battle over the Turk at Lepanto, when they were attempting to blot our Faith...their protection was the Holy Rosary. A bit later another great victory in Hungary only after all the citizens were urged to pray this beautiful devotional.

In the year of 1221, Pope Gregory XIII; and later, Pope Clement XI in 1573 and Pope Leo XIII in 1888, all did much to make the feast of the Most Holy Rosary more and more observed and revered in the Church.

The rosary is not only a prayer...it is a weapon! The little beads of love that are strung on the rosary are bullets of destruction against the enemies of the Catholic Faith and the enemies of one's salvation. In this simple chaplet, five decades of the rosary, the Holy Name of Jesus is invoked fifty-four times, and the Holy Name of Mary, one hundred and seven times.

No Catholic should ever be without a rosary. The devil is afraid of these beads as they lay in our pocket or held in our hands. During these difficult times, both in the Church and throughout the world, the Holy Rosary must be our weapon of choice.

Over the course of the next few weeks the Deacon's Corner will address the ten reasons to pray the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary and delve into the Joyful, Sorrowful, Luminous and Glorious Mysteries of this wonderful prayer.
